SCHOOLS OF RENEWAL MINISTRY

Equipping clergy and lay leaders to minister more effectively in the power of the Holy Spirit.

“To prepare God’s people for works of service so that the body of Christ may be built up.” Ephesians 4:12

WHY LEADERSHIP TRAINING?

The ACC Strategic Plan, Vision 2019, lists 7 Priorities, beginning with “Develop leadership education for mission, evangelism, and ministry.” ARM has been meeting this need for 16 years by providing leadership training designed to strengthen clergy and lay leaders to minister more effectively in the power of the Holy Spirit. The goal is teams of ARM-trained clergy and lay leaders working together to renew their parish.

SCHOOLS OF RENEWAL MINISTRY (SRMs)

Clergy SRMs are usually 4 or 5-day residential events. Through teaching, small group sharing, worship, prayer and ministry, participants develop leadership styles to initiate positive growth and equip lay leaders to share in effective ministry.

Lay SRMs are usually 3-day residential events. These courses equip lay leaders to work with clergy to develop positive change in the church.

ARM has a team of committed leaders, including retired Bishops Terry Buckle, Leonard Whitten and Eddie Marsh, and his wife, Emma.

ARM also sponsors **Weekend Parish SRMs** with at least one ARM leader, using some of the teaching from the residential programs. These events are held in a parish setting. The shorter timeframe allows for only 5 or 6 topics, but gives participants a good sense of this work.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

ARM offers residential training events for lay leaders, clergy, or bishops in the Anglican Church and their spouses. We also welcome those who provide leadership in other Christian churches.

TOPICS

- Biblical principles of leadership
- Development of a Godly vision for the community
- Dynamics of leading a parish into renewal
- Styles of leadership and congregational development
- Equipping disciples
- Empowering and gifting of the Holy Spirit
- Servant leadership and servant character

FEES

Residential SRM fees vary, depending on the retreat centre and leader travel costs. Fees include accommodation, meals and course materials. Clergy SRMs cost approx. \$650/person. Lay SRMs cost approx. \$350/person. Donations are appreciated to minimize fees.
